Community at a Glance

The Mehlville School District mission is to build a high performing school system rooted in the community's desire to build a culture of improvement for staff and students. Mehlville School District, located in South St. Louis County, Missouri, serves more than 10,200 students through its early childhood center, 11 elementary schools, four middle schools and two high schools. Students speak more than 50 different languages. The Oakville High School student body is 84% Caucasian, 7% African-American, 3% Asian, 3% Hispanic and 3% multi-racial. Of Oakville High School students, 18% receive free or reduced-priced meals, 15% receive special education services and 4% are English language learners.

Portrait of a Graduate: Mehlville School District believes that all of our graduates should be creative and critical thinkers, self-aware, persistent, communicators, and ethical and global. We call this our Portrait of a Graduate, and it guides our work with students from preschool to their senior year.

Academic Program

Class Schedule: The school calendar is divided into two semesters, consisting of two terms each. The academic program is organized as an 8 block schedule, in which the classes meet every other day (4 blocks per day).

College Dual Credit Courses: OHS offers 29 College Dual Credit Courses that may be taken on the high school campus for dual credit through the University of Missouri-St. Louis, Saint Louis University, Missouri Baptist University, Missouri State University, Saint Louis Community College and Lindenwood University: Accounting II; Business Technology; Entrepreneurship and Free Enterprise; Financial Planning; Bosnian American Studies; French III and IV; German III and IV; Microsoft Applications; Pre-Calculus; Retail Marketing Management; Shakespeare's Plays; Spanish III, IV and V; Trigonometry; Understanding Law; Advanced Acting; Advanced Competitive Forensics; Advanced Marketing; AP Biology; AP Calculus; AP Chemistry; AP English Language and Composition, AP German, AP Physics, AP US History, and College Algebra.
