### Community at a Glance

The Mehlville School District mission is to build a high performing school system rooted in the community's desire to build a culture of improvement for staff and students. Mehlville School District, located in South St. Louis County, Missouri, serves more than 10,200 students through its early childhood center, 11 elementary schools, 4 middle schools and 2 high schools. Students speak more than 50 different languages. Oakville High School's student body is 88% Caucasian, 6% African-American, 3% Asian, 2% Hispanic and 1% multi-racial. Of Oakville High School students, 18% receive free or reduced-priced meals, 18% receive special education services and 5% are English language learners.

**Portrait of a Graduate:** Mehlville School District believes that all of our graduates should be creative and critical thinkers, self-aware, persistent, communicators, and ethical and global. We call this our Portrait of a Graduate, and it guides our work with students from preschool to senior year.

### Academic Program

**Class Schedule:** The school calendar is divided into two semesters, consisting of two terms each. The academic program is organized as an 8 block schedule (7 academic blocks and 1 study block), in which the classes meet every other day (4 blocks per day).

**College Dual Credit Courses:** OHS partners with Missouri Baptist University, Saint Louis University, and University of Missouri-St. Louis to offer college dual credit courses. Current courses offered: AP Biology; AP Calculus; AP Chemistry; AP English Language & Composition; AP Macroeconomics; AP Microeconomics; AP Physics; AP Psychology; AP Spanish Language; AP U.S. Government and Politics; AP U.S. History; AP World History; Modern; Business Law; CAPS Medical; College Algebra; Financial Planning; French 3; French 4; Pre-Calculus; Spanish 3; Spanish 4; Spanish 5.
